President's Report -

Grants report - the MAC has awarded \$4,032 for the ArtSmart conference. A plan to replace this conference with the Spring speaking series was approved. The MAC grant information has been resubmitted to include this new focus.

The Speaking series will Include topics such as Social media, Business and Economics of Arts, art show jury application including photos. Sandy Brooks will talk about photographing artists' own work. Other topics discussed include:

- -Michael Ochonicky is currently teaching a class on starting an art business and is currently working with the St. Louis Community college.
- -VLAA could also have class options.

Presenters will receive stipend \$100.

This speaker series be a part of the Events Committee.

BOMH will reach out to galleries and fellow art organizations throughout the state to host the speaking series. Hannibal, Springfield, Rolla, Cape Girardeau, Columbia, St. Joseph, Branson, Lees Summit art councils have expressed interest in hosting these one day events

Allison is currently creating a logo for "BOMH on the Road"

Peggy King will be the hotel liaison for the ArtSmart Conference to be held in 2020. The current plan will be to hold the event on a Friday, Saturday and Sunday and include 2 keynote speakers. Location to be determined.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> - Motion to accept the budget into minutes was made by Lee Richards, motion passed and accepted

Communication officer and Bookkeeper are currently paid \$12,000 annually /\$500 monthly. Proposed increase to \$18,000 annually / \$700 monthly to go into effect October 1, 2018. Angie Kreiger made motion, Don Kelley seconded. Majority accepted.
