





I am writing to invite you to a Best of Missouri Hands "On the Road-The World We Create" exhibit that will be at Columbia Art League in Columbia, MO. This is an exhibit for 2-

dimensional and 3-dimensional work with a subject manner spotlighting the world around you and creative processes. Just a simple look out of any window exposes architecture, design, nature, color theory, etc. The world can be as small as your neighborhood or as vast as the entire planet.

The exhibit will be on display April 22, 2025, through May 8, 2025. The Columbia Art League is open Tuesday through Friday from 11:30 am to 6pm and Saturday from 11am to 5pm. An opening reception and awards ceremony will be held on April 25th. There will be a small \$15 entry fee for this show, but yes, *there will be cash awards* for this show.

Columbia Art League has graciously offered BOMH a three week exhibit window. We have an incredible opportunity to bring BOMH talent to the middle of Missouri. Each member can submit up to three pieces for display, with the understanding that space may dictate that not all submitted pieces will be hung.

Each piece of artwork needs to be framed and ready to hang or display with a wire across the back. No saw-tooth or triangle hangers will be allowed. Jewelry is allowed, but no locking cases are available, and pieces must be ready to display with stands, etc. Pedestals are available for 3-dimensional work. Please make a mental note that this is a child friendly venue. Columbia Art League will be able to make sales on works and will only take a 35% commission.

Columbia Art League is a beautiful space. Let's make sure to fill the space!

Important dates:

- * March 1-31: Complete application via Entrythingy.com (see link below)
- * April 19: Drop off at Columbia Art League, 207 S 9th St, Columbia, MO. 11am to 4pm only (no shipped works accepted at the venue)
- * Shipping to a local member will be announced as the show gets closer
- * April 22: Exhibit Open
- * April 25: Opening Reception

- * May 8: Exhibit closes
- * May 9 and 10: Pick up works during venue's business hours.

- After completing the entrythingy application, you will be taken to checkout to pay the \$15
 event jury fee.

APRIL 8, 2025: "Studio At Home: A guide to hosting Art Workshops in Your Home Studio" with JoAnna Jackson



Alternative sales avenues are needed, and we need to know how to best succeed in that new setting.

Friday will be optional. A day to get settled at the hotel, mingle in a relaxed hospitality room with your fellow artists, maybe do a bit of coloring or other activities. Saturday is when the conference itself will begin with Lennon's presentation. Break outs in the afternoon and then Saturday Night Shenanigans (formerly Friday Night Frolics) and hospitality room mingling. Sunday morning Lennon will talk to us again, and then we'll have the traditional and essential Mock Jury.
