

I've got some updates on my art activities from the past few months. In August I was excited to receive a first-place award in the Top 50 Juried Art Exhibit at the Missouri State Fair for my painting "Window with View of August Rain." For those unfamiliar with the Top 50 Exhibit, several weeks prior to the opening of the fair, artists from throughout the state send photos of their artwork to the fair for consideration. This year 130 artwork images were submitted. An appointed judge then picked 50 artworks for the actual physical exhibit that was displayed in the Fine Arts building during the fair. Of the 50 exhibited works, the judge picked four first-place awards from viewing the actual artworks. Since the early 1990s I've had over twenty artworks accepted into the Top 50 Exhibit, but this was the first time I

won a first-place award. However, I was honored to receive two purchase awards and several Honorable Mention awards over the years in the exhibit.

In May, the same painting won the first-place award in the DPW monthly online contest <u>The</u> DPW Monthly Contest (74 entries)

In August I won the "Best of Category" in Painting at the "Midwest Salute to the Arts" art fair held in Fairview Heights, Illinois.

In September I was commissioned to paint a design on a teepee. Working with the client I developed the design and then painted the image on the teepee. The teepee fabric was made from untreated canvass which was quite a challenge.

In October, my painting "Winter's Embrace" won third place in the exhibit "Explore the Natural World." The exhibit was sponsored by Capital Arts in Jefferson City.

My painting "A Boy's Best Friend" won the second place "Diane Knight Memorial Award" in the 37th annual Judged Art Exhibit sponsored by Arts Rolla. That exhibit hung through November 25th at the Centre located at 1200 N. Holloway in Rolla.



Learn more about the BOMH Visiting Artist Program

The goal of this program is for students to meet and learn about professional artists and their work. This may be a student's first exposure to actual artwork outside of a museum. Students regularly learn about other careers, and this program introduces them to the lives of working artists. Students view actual work up close and ask questions of the artist, developing a deeper understanding of the artist's life. Some students will go on to become professional artists themselves, and exposure to professional working artists provides a meaningful way for contemplating creative career choices. It helps deepen an appreciation for art as they become collectors of art in the future.

You must be a juried BOMH artist to apply for the Visiting Artist Program. Our artists are provided with a \$100 stipend for each visit approved and completed.

BOMH PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT GRANT

DEADLINE: February 15, 2025

The Best of Missouri Hands offers two grants of up to \$500 each annually. The grant is available to both General and Juried Members. The purpose of the grant is to promote

continuing education by providing additional resources to advance the study of a member's chosen artistic medium(s).

The grant will be awarded by early March of each year and announced at the Annual Membership Meeting that spring.

If you are interested in applying for the grant, you should be thinking about what you would like to do with it. Is there a workshop you want to take in your medium? Do you want to travel abroad to learn about a technique native to that country? Do you need to purchase a new piece of equipment that will help you advance your skills and opportunities? How about taking classes in marketing and branding your art?

There are many options open to you. What have you wanted to do with your art that has been out of your reach - something that will open doors for you or allow you to become more marketable?

SMALL BUSINESS FILING REQUIREMENT

Is your creative business operating as a limited liability company (LLC)? Take note: there's a new federal rule requiring most small businesses to file with the U.S. Treasury Department's Financial Crimes Enforcement Network (FinCEN).

LLCs and other businesses must report information about their beneficial owners — the persons who ultimately own or control the company. Companies that were created before 2024 have until the end of this year to file. Those created in 2024 have 90 days after their incorporation to file. You don't need an attorney or an accountant to complete the form, and there is no filing fee.

<u>Find the instructions and FAQs on the FinCEN website.</u> The new rules are intended to combat money laundering, terrorism financing, organized crime, and other financial crimes.
